- Screening for external parasites like fleas and ticks, which can be dangerous to you, too
- Listening to heart and lungs
- Feeling for any lump and bumps
- Possible palpation of abdominal organs like kidney, bladder, intestines, spleen and liver

Same time he/she may discuss about deworming, heartworm status, wellness blood testing, urine testing and other health conditions with you, He/she has lot many useful advises for healthy & happy living of your pet.
